New business

- Trailblazer Day - October 20, Oxford Fair Grounds. Gates open at 7:30 AM. Many activities for Cub Scouts (similar to Fun Pack Weekend), plus they can see the Boy Scouts in their camp sites as they participate in this, the biggest camporee in years. Web 2 Cubs can camp overnight with the Boy Scout troop.
- Pack Budget - distributed proposed per boy budget. Highlighted the fact that the Pack needs to raise more money to operate effectively. The following decisions were made:
  - Increase the Pack activity fee from \$12 to \$15 per Scout per year.
  - Increase the focus and effort placed on the Popcorn Fund Raiser. Each Scout will be required to either raise \$60 in profit (\$167 in sales) or increase their out of pocket contribution to make up the difference.
  - Review Pack finances after Christmas and consider additional fund raisers at that time.
- Popcorn fund raiser - this should be our premier fund raiser for the year, and if done effectively, should be the only fund raiser needed. In order to improve performance, we will be doing both "Show & Sell" and "Take Order" sales.
  - Show & Sell - MJ to coordinate with area businesses (for instance - Steven's Hardware, Sabattus Credit Union, Sabattus Transfer Station) to allow us to display and sell popcorn on their premises.

All Scouts will be required to participate by attending at least one slot in the schedule. Popcorn for this has been ordered (and received as of 9/8/07).

- Take Order - All existing Scouts should have received their Popcorn forms in the mail by now. Call MJ or Bob if you do not have yours.
- Bob to challenge the Dens to compete for the best sales effort. The Dens will report their sales each week, and Bob will publish the results each Sunday so that the Dens can see how they are doing relative to their peers. The Den with the highest sales / Scout average at the end of the campaign will be treated to a special prize (pizza party or similar). Although Show & Sell sales do not count towards a Scout's individual sales, they WILL count toward their Den's sales totals.
- 2008 Dues will be due in November Pack Meeting to make sure they are in to Council in December when they are required. Parents can pay in three installments (September, October, November) or all at once in November.
