- All Medication**... Must be checked in with the **Camp Nurse** in its original prescription or *O.T.C.* container with clear instructions.

On Time Is The Best Time!

- Camp Check-in is **8:15am** Please **Pre-register** on Sunday.. Take your son to his **Den Leader** each day before leaving him.
- Camp Check-out is at **4:30 pm sharp**. Each boy must be signed out by a parent, or someone with written permission. Let his **Den Leader** know you're picking him up.

Travel Light & Be Prepared! *We Play in the Great Outdoors, Rain or Shine!*

- Shoes & socks are **required!** No sandals, open-toed shoes, or flip-flops will be allowed at camp.
- Uniform** = Camp T-shirt Camp T-shirts will be distributed on **Sunday** and worn every day **M-F**
- Extreme Weather** Hats, sunscreen, raingear, and a water bottle are **recommended**.
- Label** your clothing! Bring a **bathing suit & towel**, and theme-related costumes to wear.
- Pack a lunch. A **small cooler** for a bag lunch, drinks, and a snack is encouraged.
