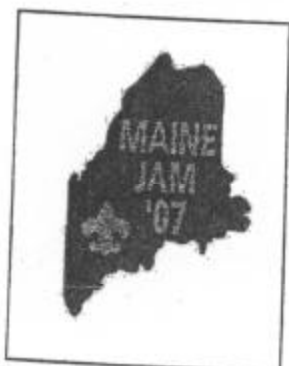

Featuring the “Mystics”, with Fireworks and a huge Laser light show!

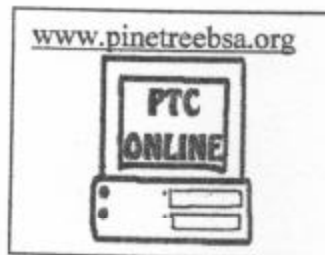
Cub Scout activities will run all day on Saturday on a first come basis.
